Purpose of the GNA-G

The Global Network Advancement Group (GNA-G) is a collaboration that provides a platform for R&E Networks to work together on the global network interconnect aspects of the Global Research and Education Network (GREN). The GNA-G has been established to facilitate an open, transparent and efficient platform to discuss and advance the global interconnect and associated services designed to meet the needs and address the challenges faced by the global research and education community. The oversight of the GNA-G is done by the GNA-G Leadership Team (LT).

The work of the GNA-G consists of gatherings, either physical or online, and work carried out in specific areas by several Working Groups (WGs). The long-term evolution of GNA-G is determined by the participants in GNA-G. The LT takes the input from the GNA-G community in order to

- · develop the strategy, work programme, and communications plan for the GNA-G;
- organise and determine the agenda of the gatherings;
- start and close WGs; and help plan, guide and synergize the work of the WGs in the context of the overall GNA-G work programme.

GNA-G LT - Terms of reference



Key items from the document

- The **GNA-G**:
 - is a virtual collaboration, with no formal or legal status
 - currently operates without a funding model or budget; depending on in-kind contributions
- The LT is the central governing function of the GNA-G
 - Develop the strategy, work programme, and communications plan for the GNA-G;
 - Create and close WGs; and help plan, guide and synergize the work of the WGs
 - Between 3 and 9 members
 - Terms of 48 months; maximum two terms
 - LT selected by NomCom; LT then elects a chair
 - Holds regular VCs; organises virtual & in-person meetings
 - May decide matters via voting
- **Integrity** is key to the LT; all conflicts of interest to be declared and managed.
- **Diversity** is fundamental to the success of the GNA-G broadly and the LT specifically.

Increased **threats**: competition, cyber, resilience, increased expectation




The motivation:

To harness the energy and enthusiasm of the community, and evolve GNA-G:


- to more rapidly take advantage of the opportunities,

Proposal: Re-align the LT and WG activities to four focus areas









Intended outcomes:

By fostering collaboration and innovation, GNA-G aims to achieve the following outcomes:

- Improved network performance: Through the sharing of best practices and the development of new technologies, GNA-G will help R&E networks improve their performance and reliability.
- Increased efficiency: By optimizing resource utilization and streamlining network interconnection, GNA-G will help R&E networks operate more efficiently.
- Enhanced security: By focusing collectively on security best practices and emerging technologies, GNA-G will help R&E networks strengthen their defenses against cyber threats.
- Next-generation services: By exploring and developing new technologies and concepts at the intersection of research and operational networks, GNA-G will help R&E networks offer next-generation services that can better support research and education.
